SESSION 1

9:00 am – 1 pm

1A Program Leadership – Daisy / Brownie

This course is for **brand new** leaders working with the Daisy or Brownie levels. You will learn and discover how to work with girls from these two levels, including how to plan and implement programs. You will also explore the characteristics of girls in grades K-3, troop decision making skills, earned awards and other program activities for each level. Fulfills the requirement for Daisy and Brownie leaders.

Prerequisite: Basic Leadership Training

1B Jump into Junior Leadership

Explore characteristics of the 4th and 5th grade girl. Learn about the patrol system, become familiar with Journeys and other Junior earned awards. Discuss other fun program activities for your Junior Troop.

1C Teen Advisor

Learn what your role is as an advisor to girls in grades 6-12. Gain sight into the characteristics of girls this age, available program resources to help them achieve their goals and when to step back so girls can develop leadership skills. Discover ways to become teen savvy, how to talk to girls about the 3T's (Touchy Teen Topics), and maintain confidentiality with troop members, plus more. Fulfills the requirement for Cadette, Senior and Ambassador advisors. **Prerequisite:** Basic Leadership Training
