Candidate Criteria:

- Made a contribution to community pluralism that impacts girls and Girl Scouting



Presentation:

- Annually
- At venue appropriate to award recipient, and may be selected by award recipient

Nomination/Selection Process:

- By individual submissions, electronic or paper:
 - On-line: Application form through www.gssjc.org found on the CIN (Council Information Network)
- Completed nominations must be transmitted to the Senior Director of Membership
- Deadline Submission: February 1st, 2010
- Selection Committee: Pluralism Committee

*Note: GSSJC Board, Pluralism Committee members and/or GSSJC staff are not eligible for the award.
This award is NOT associated with the Ervan Chew Scholarship.*
