This event uses the same registration system as college courses! To register for this event, you will need to create a profile. Enter your contact information (as a “new user”), and then log in to the registration system. Select the “Girl Scout Interest Project University,” and choose the workshops you’d like to attend. You may choose one in the morning and one in the afternoon. (You may only register for one class at a time.) Everyone who plans to attend a workshop (girl or adult) needs to register. Please note that you must register individually, not as a troop or group. **Registration is available on January 19.**

Notes: SHSU Student Ambassadors will lead the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts to workshops. All girls will receive an event patch!
