Woodworking used to be only a male hobby...that's changing! GSSJC, in partnership with our newest community partner, Woodcraft, offers a workshop to support GSSJC's Council's Own *Wild About Wood* Program Patch for Girl Scout Daisy - Ambassador to explore this exciting topic.

Learning how to make repairs can save money and lead to interesting careers – as Girl Scout Juniors discover while completing the requirements of this GSUSA's *Do It Yourself* badge. The aware requirements are located on the national web site, www.girlscouts.org

Girls, with an adult, are invited to a two (2) hour workshop to introduce you to the topics: *Wild about Wood*: professional woodworkers teach with activities linked to the program patch, including a project to make and take home.

Do It Yourself: professional woodworkers introduce the uses of tools, explain how blueprints are used concluding with a project to make & take home (*fulfills req. 1, 3 and 4*).
