



Driver Checklist Girl Scouts of San Jacinto Council

Adults in charge of activities for girls are responsible for ensuring the safety and security of girls in their care. Refer to GSSJC F-433, "Policies and Operational Procedures" and GSUSA's *Volunteer Essentials*. The adult in charge should review the following information for each driver who will be transporting Girl Scout passengers to/from Girl Scout related activities. Parents may transport only their own daughter(s) without verification of this information. Girls never drive other girls.

Driver Qualifications:

Adults transporting girls for a Girl Scout activity must meet the following requirements:

- Driver is an adult volunteer at least 21 years of age with a good driving record
- Has a current valid Driver License and auto insurance required by the state of Texas.
- No convictions of DUI or DWI in the last 5 years.
