Reminders from the Adult Recognition Committee about nominations:

- Nominated volunteers must have *completed* at least one full membership year in the role for which they are serving and being recognized.
- Nominated volunteers may not be eligible for an award if they recently received a council or national recognition.

The Adult Recognition Committee is seeking letters of nomination for volunteers you believe deserve to be recognized!

Do you know a volunteer who has done incredible service for Girl Scouts and hasn't received an award recently? We've opened a new nomination letter form on the Volunteer Recognition web page to collect individual letters of support for volunteers.

What this means for you:

- Complete the online form letter. That's it! Letters must come from an adult member in good standing – current membership with GSSJC, no debt to the council and (if serving in a volunteer role) have a current eligible criminal background check on file with the council.
- No need to collect letters from other volunteers or staff
- No need to collect the Volunteer Service Record (F-122) from the volunteer you are appreciating.

What happens next:

- Nominated volunteers who receive 3 or more nomination letters by February 1, 2027 will receive a request to complete their F-122 so they may be considered for a formal award.
- Nominated volunteers with fewer than 3 letters may be considered for other forms of recognition – like our council's monthly Volunteer Spotlight or a community-level award.

If you choose to utilize the existing forms and process to nominate a volunteer for an award, that process remains in place.
