

# Casa Mare Troop Kit Checkout

Casa Mare Troop Kits are available at the Reserve Ranger Office/Infirmary for troops camping over the weekend at Casa Mare. Kits cover a wide range of topics – from birdwatching to geocaching and teambuilding, plus more! We have kits for all Girl Scout levels, and older Girl Scouts can use kits for younger Girl Scouts as needed.

## In-Advance Checkouts

Troops can sign up before arriving at camp using the [SignUp.com](https://www.SignUp.com).

- Go to date of your weekend at camp (all days are the Friday of the weekend checkout)
- Choose a bag (or two, depending on troop size) of your first preference.
  - Attached to the [SignUp.com](https://www.SignUp.com) description is a file detailing bag contents.
- Sign up using your name and contact email; indicate the approximate number of girls who will use the bag.
- Make note of any indicators in the legend, such as (H) for heavy.
- Arrive at the Reserve Ranger Office when checking into camp to get your bag(s) from the Reserve Ranger.
- If there is an issue with your chosen bag, such as broken equipment, the Reserve Ranger can help you pick out an alternative bag.
- Return the bag to the Reserve Ranger Office when checking out with all parts stored in the correct bag.

## On-Demand Checkouts

Troops can also check out kits using the [SignUp.com](https://www.SignUp.com) when they arrive to check in.

- Arrive at the Reserve Ranger Office to check in.
- Indicate interest in checking out a Treelake Troop Kit.
- Scan QR Code for [SignUp.com](https://www.SignUp.com).
- Choose an available bag (or two, depending on troop size).
  - Attached to the [SignUp.com](https://www.SignUp.com) description is a file detailing bag contents.
- Sign up using your name and contact email; indicate the approximate number of girls who will use the bag.
- Make note of any indicators in the legend, such as (H) for heavy.
