

GSSJC COVID-19 Pretesting Option for GSSJC Camp Activities

Participants scheduled for certain activities occurring at GSSJC camp properties may be required to take a COVID-19 rapid test upon arrival at camp. Troops and individual adult volunteers may choose to self-test prior to driving to camp to ensure that everyone the group tests negative, and if doing so, may skip the testing at camp check-in. Individual girls attending camp will continue to be tested at check-in.

In order to qualify, the troop leader or designated volunteer (e.g., first aider or camp-trained volunteer) will be required to certify that the participants tested negative for COVID-19 on the same day as the arrival at camp. Pretesting may be conducted at a licensed rapid testing site or by using an at-home rapid test. GSSJC recommends having participants affirm their individual test results with the designated volunteer on arrival. This could include administering an on-site rapid test, showing the negative test result documentation from a testing site, or showing a picture that include the results of an at-home testing kit, along with the name of the individual tested and date of test.) If volunteer is conducting the testing at a location prior to arrival at camp, individuals should stay in their cars until a negative test is confirmed. Note: GSSJC will not provide tests for pre-testing.

If this option is chosen, and the adult volunteer certifies the negative test results, then those listed below will not be required to complete a rapid test on arrival at camp.

Note: Those who have recovered from COVID-19 in the last 90 days may provide a doctor’s note or confirmation of a positive test from a medical clinic or testing facility in lieu of required testing. If this applies to you or someone in your troop and you are unable to secure a doctor’s note, please contact Melissa Hardy at mhardy@sigs.org for further guidance.
