

Tour the Goodykoontz Museum of Girl Scout History



Troops, Groups, and individuals can tour the Goodykoontz Museum of Girl Scout History on a self-guided or guided basis. The museum offers the opportunity to travel through time and walk in the shoes of Girl Scouts who came before you. Although the museum's story focuses on the Southeast Texas region, it echoes the history of the Girl Scout movement nationally. Guided Tours:

Available upon scheduling (at least 4 weeks in advance). Groups are limited to 20. To book, please email museumtour@sjgs.org with the following information:

Self-Guided Tours:

Available any time the museum is open. Pre-booking is not needed for a self-guided tour, but please be advised that there may be other activities occurring throughout the museum and/or Program Place building. Feel free to use our self-guided binder available on top of the display case by the welcome desk. Please return these binders when finished so others may enjoy them.

Museum Hours (may change seasonally; always coincide with Girl Scout Shop hours): Monday-Friday: 9 a.m.—5 p.m.; Saturday: 9 a.m.—1 p.m.; Sunday: closed
